NOV. 30 1947 SUNDAY WE ALL GOT UP CLEANED UP READY FOR OUR TRIP TO BREMERTON WASH. WE ALL SAT DOWN TO EAT BREAKFAST. THE GEO. WOODGE DROVE UP. DELIVERED PEARLS HANDBAG AND WE INTRODUCED HIM TO ALL THE REST OF THE FOLKS AND WE INVITED HIM FOR BREAKFAST. WE ALL HAD A REAL GOOD BREAKFAST AND AFTER BREAKFAST WE VISITED AWHILE AND DEPARTED. WE GOT IN THE CAR AND STARTED OFF ON THE WAY THE FOLKS DECIDED TO STOP AT ARMY MARKET AT SIDNY. MARGOLIS PLAGE HE DID NOT FEEL SO GOOD. SO WE STOPPED HAD ANICE VISIT. THAY SERVED SOME REFRESHMENTS. WE ARRIVED IN BREMERTON 4 PM. IT WAS FUGGIE AND RAINING DAMP GOLD WE DROVE UP TO A NICE CAFE AND DECIDED TO HAVE DINNER, WE ALL ORDERED STEAK AND ALL THE TRIMMINGS. WE WERE ALL GOOD AND MERRY AND WE ENJOYED OUR DINNER MESSY. AFTER DINNER WE DECIDED TO GO BACK SO WE DROVE BACK TO THE DOGS GOT THERE JUST IN TIME TO GET IN THE BOAT BOAT TO SEATTLE. THE NAMES OF THE BOAT WAS KALAKIDA, ANICE BOAT.

YOU CAN STAY AND WATCH OUTSIDE WITHOUT GETTING RAINED ON. THEY HAVE A NICE RESTAURANT AND ANEWS STAND VERY NICE BOAT SHE CAN CARRY 75 CARS AND 500 PASSENGERS AND FRT. THE PRICE IS \$75 FOR OUR AND PASSENGERS. WE GOT BACK TO SEATTLE 4:30 PM. AND DECIDED TO TAKE A SNOW SO WE DROVE AROUND 4 TIMES AROUND A BLOCK LOOKING FOR A PARKING SPACE BUT NO LUCK SO WE STOPPED AT THE ROOSEVELT THEATRE LET THE WOMEN OFF AND WE DROVE TO A PARKING LOT AND LEFT THE CAR AND WALKED TO THE THEATRE AND JOINED THE WOMEN AND TOOK IN A SHOW CALLED (THE DESERT KING) WE ALL ENJOVED THE SNOW VERY MUCH. IT WAS MIDNIGHT WHEN WE GOT BACK HOME. WE VISITED A WHILE TALKED ABOUT THE TRIP HAD A ROUND OF TEA AND RETIRED. WE WERE ALL TIRED AND IT DID NOT TAKE LONG BEFORE WE WERE ALL SOUND ASLEEP. DROVE TO BREMERTON

JOSEPH STRAUSS WAS THE CHIEF ENGINEER OF THIS PROJECT. JOSEPH STRAUSS DREW THE PLANS AND ENGINEERED AND SUPERVISED THE ENTIRE JOB. AND WHEN THE BRIDGE WAS COMPLETED AND READY FOR THE DEDICATION JOSEPH STRAUSS TOOK SICK AND DIED A FEW DAYS BEFORE THE DEDICATION. HIS ACCOMPISHMENT THEY ERRECTED A MONUMENT FOR HIM AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE BRIDGE WHERE HIS OFFICE WAS WHILE THE BRIDGE WAS UNDER CONSTRUCTION. THE BRIDGE IS NEARLY 3 MILE LONG. THE MAIN STRUCTURE IS 940 FEET LONG. THE TOWER'S HEIGHT WITH THE 400 FEET LONG. THE NEW SPAN IS 4200 FEET LONG. THE FEET HIGH. THE NEW SPAN IS 4200 FEET LONG. THERE ARE 2-10 FOOT SIDEWALKS FOR FOOT TRAFFIC AND LINES FOR VEHICLES. TRAFFIC TO GO WITH 90 FEET TOTAL LENGTH. IN ALL THIS TRAFFIC THERE IS 7 MILES LONG. COST 35,000,000. THE BRIDGE IS A BRIDGE EVER BUILT AND WERE

A RED WOOD TREE IS INDESTRUCTIBLE WHENEVER ELEMENTS THREATEN TO DESTROY A TREE. IMMEDIATELY A NEW FAMILY STARTS FROM THE ROOTS. A CLUSTER OF 300-400 NEW TREES AND IN THAT WAY THEY ARE INDESTRUCTIBLE IF A TREE GETS WOUNDED IN SOME WAY. THERE'S A CERTAIN PITCH COMES OUT AND HEALS UP THE SPOT. JUST LIKE AROUND PITCH. SOME OF THE TREES DATE BACK TO 500 B.C. SOME OF THEM STAND UP TO 300 FEET TALL.

VERY LITTLE SUNSHINE HERE. BECAUSE THE SUN DON'T PENETRATES THROUGH ALL THE THICK FOREST NOT MUCH UNDERGROUND WILDLIFE WERE BECAUSE OF LACK OF SUNSHINE.
