PORTLAND'S ANNUAL RAINFALL IS 41 1/2 INCHES WITH 15% OCCURRING IN THE WINTER—21% IN THE SPRING 7% IN THE SUMMER SIDE A GREEN AND GROWING LAND THAT LOST THE YEAR. ALTITUDE AVERAGE 115 FEET DOWN TOWN 32 FEET. AREA 66 1/2 SQUARE MILES. A FEWS 42 1/2. WATER SUPPLY IS TAKEN FROM THE WILLAMETTE RIVER. IT IS USED DIRECTLY IN STORAGE BOTTIES.
