WEDNESDAY DEC. 17-1947 WE GOT UP AT 730 AM CLEANED UP HAD OUR BREAKFAST AND BOUGHT TICKETS FOR A SIGHT SEEING TOUR. WE STARTED ABOUT 9 AM.
